

## What A Day

No one likes to communicate things like this but I must: First Baptist Church is Would you consider making an extra facing two imminent financial challenges. The first concerns our annual budget. For the first three months of 2024, we are inthe-red \$46,000 (receipts to budget requirements). And we have, as of the end of March, spent \$46,500 more than we received). Brothers and sisters, this should not be! Ministry hopes, goals, programs, community and worldwide needs, trips, personnel, general maintenance, etc., all hang in the balance. As a church family, we approved this budget. It's up to us to fund it.

Yes. I know there are siren calls for your contributions from all corners (from family to light bills to car repairs to recreational opportunities, etc.). I'm asking you to look at your bank statement/app/online account. Is your giving to the church at the by the Ordination Council at the conclulevel it should be/could be? My question is not intended to evoke guilt. Please don't tion certificate also signed by the Counrespond to it that way. It's intended to provoke thought. Spring is a season of new beginnings. Maybe your new beginning starts with a change in your giving.

The second financial challenge concerns the replacing of HVAC systems in our aging buildings. We replaced the air conditioning in the sanctuary a few years ago. But we still retained a sixty-year-old boiler for heat. That boiler is at the end of its usefulness. At the same time, the air handler in our old educational building (upstairs) has quit functioning (your teenagers/young adults have not had heat since early December and won't have AC until it's replaced). These two issues alone

will cost the church well over \$100,000. (over and above your tithe) gift to fund these massive maintenance challenges?

What a day we had last Sunday! We celebrated God's working among us-God's Call among us! Rev. Braeden Webb (I have to use first names now so you'll know which Rev. Webb we're addressing!) has evidenced the call of God on his life in so many ways. To hear the spooky, midnight story of God's summoning him to ministry ("Come! Follow Me!") was humbling, moving, encouraging, enlightening.

We ran short on time so, JICYMI, we (First Baptist Church) gave Braeden four items at the conclusion of the second service: a personalized, app enabled, NLT Bible (at his request) signed sion of Saturday's meeting, an ordinacil, a personalized copy of the Book of Common Prayer, and a personalized copy of *Psalms of the Bible*.

This Sunday, we celebrate what God has been doing through your commitment to college students/young adults as we celebrate Presbyterian College Day at First Baptist. We will baptize Emma Yanes (a PC junior) and be led in worship by many other PC students in both services. PC President Anita Gustafson is also planning on joining us.
